Practical Information

Venue

The programme on Friday, 20 April 2018, will take place in the congress and exhibition centre "Grønnegades Kasernes Kulturcenter", centrally located in Næstved with free car parking available and walking distance to the train station.

Exhibition area

In connection to the event, there will be an exhibition area with a number of stands where organisations, development agencies and business associations will present their offers and activities when it comes to export and internationalization.

Working language

The working language of the event is English. However, there will be one session in Danish language (track 2), targeted at Danish participants.

Price

Participation in the event is free of charge. However, accommodation and travel costs are not included. There will be a no-show-fee of 500 DKK for participants who, without notice, do not show at the event.

Public transport

Næstved can easily be reached by train from Copenhagen. There are frequent departures. The journey takes one hour and costs approx. 220 DKK (30 Euros) for a return ticket.



Business Næstved (Næstved Erhverv)

Business Næstved is the business development agency in Næstved Municipality which is located 80 kilometres southwest of the Danish capital city, Copenhagen.

The agency provides local companies with network, business events, guidance and relevant information on a large scale of topics.

Business Næstved is established through a co-operation between Næstved Municipality and the local Business Association (Næstved Erhvervsforening). Business Næstved has seven employees.

Næstved Municipality is with its 83,000 inhabitants the 14th largest municipality in Denmark and the 2nd largest in Region Zealand in terms of population and number one in the region in terms of area (681 square kilometres). More than one half of the municipality's population lives in the city of Næstved, the rest in the surrounding smaller towns and countryside. Næstved is hosting several educational institutions and public services (hospital, regional police, district court, harbour and municipal administration).

The business community in Næstved is characterized by a variety of companies and entrepreneurs within different branches. There are big and medium-sized industries which manufacture, among other things, glass for food packaging, ventilation systems, medico products, machinery, and building materials. Furthermore, Næstved has a strong position within the construction sector, retail trade and as a regional centre for banks, auditing companies and business services.

The local business community has, over the recent years, experienced a positive development with economic growth, more jobs being created and numerous entrepreneurs starting up. For the municipality it is a top priority to create good conditions for the businesses in terms of access to sufficient labour force, infrastructure and a business-friendly approach to the private sector in the municipal administration.
